MISC. ORDER 2020-001

By the Court:

On April 17, 2020, the Third District Court of Appeal filed an Implementation Order for the Renewed Order Pursuant to Rule 8.66 of the California Rules of Court (Renewed Order). The Renewed Order extended all time periods specified by the California Rules of Court that occur during the time period between April 20, 2020, through and including May 18th, 2020, for 30 days from the date of the specified event, except that the time to file a petition for rehearing or a request for publication and the date of finality shall not, under any circumstances, be extended by more than 30 days.

The Renewed Order provided that the court retains discretion to disallow an extension of time, to order that an action be taken or an event occur within a specified time frame, or to vacate the Renewed Order should conditions justifying its entry abate. The court hereby exercises its discretion to order that the automatic extension provided by the Renewed Order does not apply to any briefs in juvenile dependency appeals and writs. A party may seek an extension of time from the court by filing an application for extension of time.
