I urge the Judicial Council to adopt <u>ALL</u> of the SEC Report recommendations.

Consider the following questions.

- Is the AOC accountable to the voters of this state?
- Is the AOC accountable to the local communities where trial judges serve?
- Is the AOC accountable to the Judicial Council?

After reading the Legislative Analyst Office report on CCMS and the Strategic Evaluation Committee's report, I believe the answer to these questions is a resounding **NO**. Clearly, the Judicial Council has abandoned its oversight role in monitoring the AOC and I was deeply disappointed to hear that at last month's meeting that the Judicial Council failed to adopt, at the very least, the SEC Recommendation Numbers 4-1 to 4-4 (Judicial Council Oversight). To me this shows that the Judicial Council has forsaken its duty to oversee the AOC.

The SEC report recommendations are consistent with its findings and I strongly urge implementation as soon as possible. Failure to act now would be the greatest failure of our branch.
