Summary

The Health and Safety Code authorizes a court procedure to establish the fact, date, and place of a death, birth, or marriage for the purpose of creating a delayed official record of the event when no record of the event was previously made or can be obtained. In October 2003, effective January 1, 2004, the Judicial Council approved optional forms for a petition for an order establishing the fact, date, and place of a death under section 103450, and a supporting declaration.¹

Events since 2004 necessitate changes in the forms previously approved by the council. In addition to proposing revisions of the existing forms concerning a death, the Probate and Mental Health Advisory Committee proposes new form petitions and supporting declarations for establishing the fact, date, and place of a birth or a marriage.

Discussion

Health and Safety Code sections 103450–103490 set forth a procedure to establish, by court order, the fact, date, and place of a death, birth, or marriage when no official record of the event exists or can be obtained. The court order leads to a delayed official record of the event, a certificate of death, birth, or marriage filed with the California Department of Public Health,

Office of Vital Records. Section 103450 authorizes a verified petition by a beneficially interested person for an order establishing the fact, date, and place of the death, birth, or marriage to be filed in the superior court of the county where the event allegedly occurred or where the person whose event is to be established is a resident or, in the case of a death, was domiciled on the date of death. Upon the filing of the petition, the court must schedule an ex parte hearing. If the facts alleged in the petition are established to the satisfaction of the court at the hearing, the court may make an order determining that the death, birth, or marriage in fact took place on the date and at the place shown by the evidence.

The order must be prepared on a form prescribed and furnished by the state registrar of vital statistics.² The order becomes effective when a court-certified copy of it is filed with the California Department of Public Health. When that occurs, that department, through its Office of Vital Records, registers and files a delayed certificate of death, birth, or marriage. Although the court order must be prepared on the form provided by the state registrar, the Department of Public Health has not developed a form for the verified petition.

Existing forms MC-360 and MC-360A

In 2003, the Probate and Mental Health Advisory Committee proposed and the council approved, effective January 1, 2004, optional Judicial Council forms for a petition and supporting declaration to establish a record of death under section 103450, the *Petition to Establish Record of Death* (form MC-360), and the *Declaration in Support of Petition to Establish Record of Death* (form MC-360A). These forms have not been revised since their effective date.

Changes after 2004 in the structure of state government responsible for maintaining death, birth, and marriage records require revision of these forms. In 2007, the vital statistics function of the former Department of Health Services was transferred to the Department of Public Health.³ The former department is identified in the Notice text box on page 1 of form MC-360. More important, after this reorganization, the internet address (URL) shown in the text box for the Office of Vital Records changed. The URL is an important source of detailed information for potential petitioners about the court process and the necessary steps after completion of that process to file a certificate of death with the Office of Vital Records. The revised form would identify the correct department and provide the current URL.

Place of death. Item 2 of existing form MC-360 and item 3 of existing form MC-360A limit the place of death to a state in the United States. Sections 103450–103490 do not expressly limit this relief to events occurring in California specifically or in the United States generally. The section chief of the Birth and Marriage Section of the Office of Vital Records has advised this committee's staff that her unit registers all births and marriages for which there is a court order, without restrictions on the places of births or marriages.

The proposals have not been approved by the Judicial Council and are not intended to represent the views of the council, its Rules and Projects Committee, or its Policy Coordination and Liaison Committee.

Section 102100 says that "[e]ach live birth, fetal death, death, and marriage that *occurs in the state* shall be registered as provided in this part." (Italics added.) "[T]his part" refers to Part 1, Vital Records, of Division 102 of the Health and Safety Code, sections 102100–103800. But section 103490, in the specific context of the delayed certificate procedure, twice refers to events determined by the court to have occurred outside this state, thereby inferring that in that context, no limitation of the events to California was intended. The advisory committee does not interpret section 102100 as prohibiting a more specific portion of Part 1, such as sections 103450–103490, from providing for or permitting registration of deaths, births, or marriages that occur outside California in appropriate circumstances. In this situation, the appropriate circumstances are a missing or unavailable official record of the event and California residency, or domicile at death, of the person whose event is involved. The revised forms would permit and provide space for the petition and the supporting declaration to allege that a death occurred in any state of the United States or in any foreign country.

Disclosure of related litigation. The existing supporting declaration for a petition to establish the fact of a death, form MC-360A, contains an item requesting the declarant to state that the death or its date, time, or place is important to pending litigation, preceded by a check box. If the check box is selected, the declarant is to provide information about the litigation but is given limited space to do so and no option to refer to an attachment for the purpose. The revised form retains this item but it is modified by eliminating the check box, requiring the declarant to affirmatively state that the event either is or is not important to such litigation and providing space for the requested information about the litigation and an invitation to provide additional information on an attachment. The changes in this item should reduce the number of declarants who simply do not select the item, provide a way for declarants to give the requested information about litigation to which the delayed record is important, and require declarants to make affirmative statements about the presence or absence of collateral litigation that might be affected by judicial establishment of the event alleged in the petition.

The statute does not refer to or expressly require disclosure of related litigation. This item was included in the original supporting declaration and is retained because these proceedings are entirely ex parte; no notice to anyone is required. There is authority for the proposition that a court may entirely disregard as without evidentiary weight an order establishing a birth, death, or marriage under section 103450, et seq., or the delayed certificate registered under the order, in litigation where the fact, date, or place of the event are important. (See *Estate of De Passe* (2002) 97 Cal.App.4th 92 at 104–105, and *Schmidt v. Retirement Board* (1995) 37 Cal.App.4th 1204 at pages 1210–1216.)

Section 103475 provides that if the allegations of the petition are established to the court's satisfaction at the hearing, the court *may* make an order determining that the death, birth, or marriage occurred on the date and at the place shown by the proof offered at the hearing. The court is not required to do so. In a case where related litigation involving parties not before the court may be impacted by an order entered under this procedure the court may decline to make

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the order, consolidate the proceeding with the other litigation, or exercise its discretion to require notice and an opportunity for the other parties to that litigation to be heard before making its decision.

Other proposed changes. The names of the forms would also be changed, from *Petition to Establish Record of Death*, and *Declaration in Support of Petition to Establish Record of Death*, to *Petition to Establish Fact, Time, and Place of Death*, and *Declaration in Support of Petition to Establish Fact, Time, and Place of Death*. The new names more accurately describe the relief the petition asks the court to grant, which is a determination of the fact, time, and place of death. The court's order eventually leads to an official record of the event, but only if the successful petitioner submits a certified copy of the order to the Office of Vital Records. The court does not establish the official record, and the petition does not request the court to do so.

The revised form MC-360 also includes more readable and complete instructions in the Notice text box, retitled "Notice to Petitioners," on page 1 of the form. The larger size of the text box requires the form to increase from one to both sides of a single piece of paper. But this change permits more space for responses to items in the body of the form. The additional space should result in more complete responses to these items without having to resort to additional attachment pages, possibly making the overall length of future filings shorter. The supporting declaration, form MC-360A, would also increase to two sides of a single piece of paper to increase the space available to respond to items 4, 5, and 6 without attachment pages.

New forms MC-361, MC-361A, MC-362, and MC-362A

The following new forms are proposed:

- *Petition to Establish Fact, Time, and Place of Birth* (form MC-361)
- Declaration in Support of Petition to Establish Fact, Time, and Place of Birth (form MC-361A)
- *Petition to Establish Fact, Time, and Place of Marriage* (form MC-362)
- Declaration in Support of Petition to Establish Fact, Time, and Place of Marriage (form MC-362A)

These forms are identical to the revised forms MC-360 and MC-360A, except as necessary to refer to births or marriages and to living persons as participants in these events, and to identify the appropriate Office of Vital Statistics court order forms in the Notice to Petitioners text box for each type of delayed certificate (VS 109 for death, VS 108 for birth, and VS 122 for marriage).

Specific Comments Requested

The revised forms remain optional, and the new forms concerning births and marriages are also proposed as optional forms. But the committee desires comments as to whether all of these forms should be proposed for adoption as mandatory forms.

If the forms do become mandatory, their use would be required for all petitioners in all courts. The forms would replace all local court forms and attorney-drafted documents. The Office of Vital Records would then be able to provide greater publicity about the availability of these forms, and their preparation and use, in its public information publications. The allegations and supporting evidence required in proceedings under sections 10340–103490 would become much more consistent and uniform throughout the state.
