Revenue Distribution Training—Break out Session B Steps to Distributions

As part of Session B, participants will independently perform four (4) distributions using the mock case information provided for each case study. In preparation for this hands-on exercise, it is recommended that the information below be gathered (e.g., current Board of Supervisors (BOS) resolutions) and brought to the session for group review and/or discussion. Note: For training purposes, if local or court/case specific authorized amounts are unknown or unavailable, use the amounts provided for each case study. The mock case information reflects the maximum amount authorized by statute.

Step 1: Gather information about the citation (from the case management system/case file).

- Violation type (infraction or misdemeanor)
- Violation date and conviction date
- Disposition on each count (e.g., conviction, traffic school)
- Prior violations
- Code section(s) violated
 - ✓ Confirm statute in the *California Legislative Information* <u>Leg.Info</u> website.
 - ✓ Search for authorized distributions in the State Controller's Office <u>Guidelines</u> (Revision 29).
- Arresting agency:
 - ✓ If applicable, refer to <u>Penal Code1463.002</u> for city/county percentage split.
- Base fine amount \$___:
 - ✓ Refer to the 2019 Uniform Bail & Penalty Schedules <u>UB&PS</u> (Tip: If code section is not in the UB&PS (e.g., Health & Safety) obtain the authorized amount from local bail schedule.)

Step 2. Obtain current authorized amount by county BOS resolutions for applicable local penalties.

Step 3: Determine other case and/or court specific factors and obtain current authorized amount.

Confirm local and case specific fee amounts as they can and do vary from county to county. As an example, these fees and assessments are specific to a DUI case:

- ✓ Penal Code 1463.13 Alcohol and Drug Assessment (BOS: up to \$150)
- ✓ Penal Code 1463.14 (b) DUI Lab Test Penalty (BOS: up to \$50)

 - ✓ Research *Guidelines* for applicable distributions authorized for VC 23152 (a, b) violations.
- Base fine amount: \$

Scenario #2-

 Add a second traffic infraction violation, same disposition. <u>Vehicle Code 22450 (a)</u>, Failure to Stop at Stop Sign

WATCH OUT FOR: Any special distribution requirements and ensure that violations are cited on the same incident (citation).

Case Study # 2 Base Enhancement Distribution, Health and Safety violation

Case Information. To the extent available, substitute accordingly with local court/county information.

- Arresting Agency San Diego County Sheriff
- Violation H&S 11364(a), Possession of Controlled Substance Paraphernalia
 - ✓ Research *Guidelines* for applicable distributions authorized for violations of H&S 11364 (a).
- Violation Type Misdemeanor
- Disposition Guilty
- Base fine amount: \$350 (San Diego Court 2019 Bail Schedule, pg. 21)
 - ✓ See 2019 Uniform Bail and Penalty Schedules <u>UB&PS</u> (Tip: If code section is not in the UB&PS (e.g., Health & Safety violations) obtain the authorized base fine amount from the local bail schedule.)

- Disposition Traffic School

- Violation Type = Infraction
- Disposition = Bail forfeiture
- Base fine amount: \$
 - ✓ See 2019 Uniform Bail and Penalty Schedules <u>UB&PS</u>
