The Judicial Council regretfully opposes AB 808, which would allow a court to appoint a private attorney to represent a child in a custody or visitation proceeding who has not met the training, education, and/or experience requirements set forth in the California Rules of Court.

The council opposes AB 808 because it would essentially reverse the increased training and education requirements that help protect children in custody and visitation cases. It is important that our most vulnerable citizens, specifically our children, are represented by attorneys who are cognizant of the special and specific needs that minors have when they appear before the court. The council has worked with the legislature session after session to secure the appointment of qualified individuals to represent members of the public with specialized needs, no matter what the case type or court department they appear in. It should further be noted that these training requirements do not add any additional continuing legal education hours than would otherwise be required, but instead merely specify the types of training that those hours should include.
