Dear Senator Lara:

The Judicial Council supports those provisions of AB 935 that are consistent with AB 689, as it was amended on March 16 of this year, which was held by the Assembly Appropriations Committee. AB 935 updates and revises the Welfare and Institutions Code provisions that govern procedures for when a juvenile's competency is called into question in delinquency proceedings.

Those provisions of AB 935 that are consistent with AB 689 will create consistency statewide in conducting competency hearings in delinquency cases, while still allowing counties to pursue diversion programs that have been effective with their local populations. The bill will clarify procedures, identify the burden of proof, and require courts to provide services to minors in an attempt to help restore and maintain competency.
