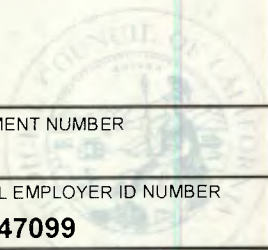


MASTER AGREEMENT AMENDMENT COVERSHEET

- All capitalized terms not defined in this amendment (the "Amendment") have the meanings given to them in the Master Agreement referenced above. As set forth in the Master Agreement, the term "Contractor" refers to **Cascade International Technologies, Inc.**, and the term "Judicial Council", "AOC" or "State" refers to the **Judicial Council of California**.
- The Amendment becomes effective on **November 1, 2015**.
- The maximum amount that the Judicial Council may pay Contractor under the Master Agreement (as amended) is \$0.00, and remains unchanged.
- The Parties agree to amend the Master Agreement as follows:
 Notwithstanding Exhibit C – Master Agreement Terms and Conditions, Section 1. Term, the Judicial Council and Contractor agree to extend the term of the Master Agreement through **October 31, 2016**.
- Except as provided in this Amendment, all terms and conditions of the original Master Agreement (as previously amended, if applicable) remain in full force and effect.

DARFUR CONTRACTING ACT CERTIFICATION
