Discussion	California Rules of Court, rule 2.400 regarding the handling of court records, and rules 3.58 and 3.60 relating to fee waiver applications, refer to court "attaché[s]" when identifying those persons who may have access certain court business. "Attaché" is a French term for a person who is assigned to the administrative staff of a higher placed person. Because the term is both undefined in the rules and relatively arcane, it may create unnecessary confusion.
	Consistent with the move toward plainer language in the rules, rules 2.400, 3.58 and 3.60 would be amended, effective January 1, 2008, to replace "attaché" and "attachés" with the clearer term "authorized court personnel."
