Title	<i>Offer to Compromise and Acceptance Under Code of Civil Procedure Section 998 (approve form CIV-090)</i>
Summary	<i>Offer to Compromise and Acceptance Under Code of Civil Procedure</i> <i>Section 998</i> (form CIV-090) would be approved, effective January 1, 2008, as an optional form for litigants to use in making and accepting offers to compromise under Code of Civil Procedure section 998.

Discussion	Code of Civil Procedure section 998 concerns offers to allow judgment to be taken or an award to be entered in pending actions. This statute was amended effective January 1, 2006, to require that the acceptances of a judgment or award must be in writing. There is presently no Judicial Council form available either for making an offer under section 998 or for accepting such an offer.
	The public would benefit from having such a standard form available. In particular, it would assist self-represented litigants engaged in the section 998 offer and acceptance process. But the proposed form could be used by any litigants, including ones represented by counsel.
	The new Judicial Council form to implement section 998 would be optional. This would allow litigants flexibility in preparing and responding to offers to compromise; they would be able either to use the new form or to prepare their own form.
	A form similar to form CIV-090, also titled <i>Offer to Compromise and</i> <i>Acceptance Under Code of Civil Procedure Section 998</i> , but designated as form CM-190, was previously circulated for public comment in the spring of 2006. Most of the comments received on form CM-190 were favorable, but a few commentators expressed concerns that the form did not sufficiently clarify the issues and consequences of offers to compromise under Code of Civil Procedure section 998.
	One concern was that the proposed form was ambiguous regarding the inclusion of attorney's fees and costs in a section 998 offer and that this

ambiguity might trap unwary litigants in unanticipated outcomes. To address this concern, the Civil and Small Claims Advisory Committee has further revised item 2 of the *Offer to Compromise and Acceptance Under Code of Civil Procedure Section 998* to clarify whether an offer of compromise includes an award or payment of attorney's fees or costs and in what amount.

The revised form is meant primarily for use in simple cases. However, as it is presently designed, it may be used in cases involving multiple parties. The form specifically includes places for identifying multiple parties. (See form CIV-090, items 1 and 3.) A question has been raised whether the form needs to be further revised to cover the situation where an offer (in item 1) is for judgment in favor of multiple parties, but the acceptance or acceptances received (in item 3) are for few than the total number of parties listed in item 1. Instead of revising the form to address this issue, an alternative approach might be to revise the entire form so that its use is limited to cases involving only two parties (that is, one plaintiff and one defendant).

Comments are invited on this revised *Offer to Compromise and Acceptance Under Code of Civil Procedure Section 998*, particularly on (1) the sufficiency and clarity of the language regarding awards or payments of attorney's fees and costs; and (2) the use of the form in multiparty cases.
