The proposed form is intended to facilitate a party's providing written notice of intent to appear by telephone.

Discussion	Recently amended rule 3.670 provides that a party must provide notice to the court and other parties of intent to appear by telephone. If a notice of telephonic appearance is not included below the title of the moving, opposition, or reply papers, notice may be given either orally or in writing, at least three court days before the appearance. The proposed form will provide a simple and uniform method of giving this written notice to the court and other parties.
