Discussion	The <i>Notice of Appeal—Felony (Defendant)</i> (form CR-120) contains several checkboxes to indicate the grounds for appeal. Frequently, the checkboxes are marked incorrectly by self-represented defendants who are unclear about which grounds for appeal apply. To reduce confusion and misuse by self-represented defendants, this proposal recommends separating the checkboxes to emphasize the appropriate grounds for appeal and adding two specific instructions for filling out the form.
	In addition, to enhance the amount of information contained in the form, this proposal recommends providing additional advisements regarding the available grounds for appeal and requirements for completion of the form.
