Remember, you may not serve the other party. The papers must be served by someone over the age of 18 who will complete the proof of service by summons (FL-115). If you don't have someone in mind, other options are to hire a process server, or ask the Sheriff for assistance (they will assist for free with a fee waiver, otherwise they charge a fee for this service).

PLEASE REMEMBER TO BRING DOCUMENTS RELATED TO:

Real Property (houses, land)
Pensions/Retirement Accounts/401k
Your 3 Most Recent Pay Stubs
Last 2 Years of Tax Returns

Double check: is there anything you OR your spouse owns that you have not listed above?

Remember all earnings and all debts during the marriage are community property – it does not matter whose name was on it or which party was working.

Separate property is debts or earnings before the marriage or after separation, as well as gifts and inheritance given to one party at any time.

Separate property must still be listed.
