HOW TO:

• Get a trial date to finish your divorce when your Husband/Wife has filed the Petition or Response but hasn't done anything else to finish the case.

WHEN TO USE:

If You have filed a Petition or Response and your husband/wife has filed a Petition or Response but your divorce is not final.

Note: If your husband/wife filed the Petition you need to file a Response, not an At-Issue Memorandum.

Note: If You filed the Petition and your husband/wife recently filed a Response, wait and give the Court time to schedule a Case Management Conference appointment for you. You don't need to file an At-Issue Memorandum right away.
