Complete answers are far more helpful because they will reduce the time necessary for follow-up questioning in court.

It is also extremely important that your answers to these questions be exclusively your own. Accordingly, you must fill out the questionnaire by yourself and not discuss the questions or your answers with anyone else. We do not want to embarrass anyone. If there is an extremely sensitive or embarrassing answer and you would feel more comfortable discussing your answer in private with the judge and attorneys, you may so indicate on the questionnaire in the space provided for your answer to that question by marking the particular question "*Confidential*."

Please do not write on the back of any page and please use a pen to fill out the

questionnaire. The questionnaire must be copied so that each attorney and the Court has a copy. If you need to make further comments regarding any of your answers, you may do so on the explanation sheet attached to the back of your questionnaire. Please do not speculate about the evidence to be presented in this case based on any question contained in this questionnaire. If you are selected to serve, you will be given all of the facts during the trial.

Please make sure you sign and date the last page.

If you claim an extreme hardship that would prevent you from serving as a juror in this case, please complete the hardship form and return to court at the designated time.
