- SUBJECT: Civil Forms: Claims of Exemption (revise forms EJ-160 and WG-006) (Action Required)

Issue Statement

Claim of exemption forms, which are initially filed with the levying officer and only later, in some instances, filed with the court, do not include separate spaces for filing stamps by both the levying officer and the court. The revised *Claim of Exemption (Enforcement of Judgment)* (form EJ-160) and *Claim of Exemption (Wage Garnishment)* (form WG-006) provide individual blocks for each filing stamp.

Recommendation

The Civil and Small Claims Advisory Committee recommends that the Judicial Council, effective January 1, 2009, revise:

- 1. Claim of Exemption (Enforcement of Judgment) (form EJ-160); and
- 2. Claim of Exemption (Wage Garnishment) (form WG-006).

The revisions provide separate spaces on each form for a court and a levying officer to file-stamp the form. The revisions also provide that item 1 on each form will include a space to enter the name of the claimant.

The text of revised forms EJ-160 and WG-006 are attached at pages 3-4.

Rationale for Recommendation

Claims of exemption are filed by judgment debtors seeking relief from levies on property or bank accounts, or from wage garnishments. The judgment debtor returns the claim not to the court, but to the levying officer who served the *Notice of Levy* or *Earnings Withholding Order*. The levying officer stamps the documents as filed upon receipt, using the box at the top right of the current forms.

If a judgment creditor opposes the claim of exemption, the judgment creditor files a notice of opposition with the court and serves that document on the levying officer. Only at that point does the levying officer file the original claim of exemption with the court. The court must then file-stamp the document, in what little room remains in the box at the top right of the current forms. A request has been made by court administrators that an additional box be added to each form to assure that there is space for the court to add its own file stamp. The revised forms provide the requested boxes.

A new item 1 has been added to the *Claim of Exemption (Wage Garnishment)* (Form WG-006), in which to enter the name of the person making the claim. The subsequent items on the form have been renumbered accordingly. This item already exists in *Claim of Exemption (Enforcement of Judgment)* (Form EJ-160), but the text has been slightly revised on that form so that the item will be identical on both forms. The revised text of item 1 states "My name is: _____."

In addition, the attorney and party information box (top left) and county and court address box (second box on left) have been revised to conform to current Judicial Council form standards. This includes providing spaces for an e-mail address and fax number.

Alternative Actions Considered

The committee considered deferring these requested changes to the forms, in light of the committee's intent to consider all forms and rules regarding enforcement of judgments in the near future. However, these changes are simple and straightforward enough that the committee recommends they be made without further delay.

Comments From Interested Parties

The proposed revisions were circulated for comment in the spring 2008 comment cycle. Six individuals or organizations, including several courts, provided comments. All agreed with the proposal. A chart summarizing the comments and the committee's responses is set forth at page 5.

Implementation and Costs

Courts may incur some minor costs in making the new forms available to the public.
