Submitting an electronic copy will satisfy the requirements for service on the Supreme Court under rule 8.212(c)(2).

Counsel shall continue to serve paper copies according to the additional service requirements of the California Rules of Court, rule 8.360(d), unless a party agrees to accept electronic service. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 8.71(2).)

Self-represented parties may, but are not required to, comply with this order. If this order causes undue hardship or significant prejudice to any party, the party shall not be required to comply with this order and may file an unbound 4<sup>th</sup> paper copy in lieu of an electronic copy.
