Dear Mr. Navarrete:

At oral argument on September 3, 2019, respondent may discuss the following decision, which is relevant to appellant's claim of error regarding the admission of his confession (Argument II of AOB). In *People v. Bradford* (1997) 14 Cal.4th 1005, 1040, this Court stated that it could not conclude that a violation of *Edwards v. Arizona* (1981) 451 U.S. 477, "unaccompanied by any actual coercion or other circumstances calculated to undermine the suspect's ability to exercise his free will, so taints the investigatory process that a subsequent voluntary and informed waiver is ineffective for some indeterminate period." (Citing *Oregon v. Elstad* (1985) 470 U.S. 298, 309.) Rather, this Court held, if the statement made after an *Edwards* violation is voluntary, "the admissibility of any subsequent statement should turn in these circumstances solely on whether it is knowingly and voluntarily made." (*Ibid.*)
