Please inform the court appellant will concentrate on the following issues at oral argument on April 4:

AOB II. The trial court's decision to admit irrelevant and prejudicial evidence of three gang-related homicides and a purported drive-by shooting was an abuse of discretion and violated appellant's rights under the Fifth, Eighth, and Fourteenth Amendments;

AOB III. The ubiquitous gang hearsay introduced at trial was testimonial hearsay in violation of appellant's Sixth Amendment right to confront the witnesses against him, and was furthermore inherently unreliable and should have been excluded under both state and federal law; and

SUPPLEMENTAL: The erroneous admission of case-specific hearsay related by the prosecution's gang expert prejudiced appellant in both the guilt and penalty phases.
