The vendor's proposal should indicate if they can provide real-time and/or post production closed captioning services in the other languages that are considered desirable but not required.

And if not, ae we able to submit a proposal without attending the proposer's conference?	The proposer's conference was not mandatory. The conference was not archived. There was one question asked during the conference and the answer has been posted (see above) along with minor revisions to the RFP.
