

1. Male minor, age 17, no prior arrest record. Youngest of four children. Other siblings are ages 24, 30, 32. Minor is not completing work at school and is receiving all "F"s.
Minor has a substance abuse problem. While under the influence of cocaine, meth or alcohol, minor becomes angry and upset, yells and curses at mother. On the occasion that led to the arrest, minor threatened to hit his mother and broke into her locked bedroom by forcing the door open. Minor did not actually make physical contact with mother. The police detained minor and he was released on house arrest at his detention hearing 5 days later.
Minor is remorseful and claims to forget what he does while under the influence. Father's whereabouts listed as unknown. Body of report suggests mother may not be sure who the father is.
2. Female minor, age 15, no prior arrest record. Minor had a pattern of leaving the home with friends and not returning home. Mother took minor to police station to request help with her "incurable" daughter. When they returned home, minor tried to leave. During the course of the argument that ensued, minor threw bleach at her mother and hit mother's boyfriend on the back.
Mother took minor to therapy 3rd – 5th grades after witnessing violence by father against mother. Father now in state prison.
Good student until high school when she started hanging out with wrong crowd. Minor smokes marijuana daily.
Minor was detained until disposition hearing (20 days).
3. Female minor, age 16. No prior arrests. Punched mother because she would not allow minor to attend a football game. Minor was taken to police station but then released back to mother.
Minor has been in counseling for 2 years. Mother has difficulty accepting minor's sexual orientation.
No prior domestic violence in the home. No substance abuse reported for minor.
4. Male minor, age 17. Pushed stepfather in the flower bushes and struck him numerous times with a closed fist. Grabbed a baseball bat and banged on stepfather's window, threatening to kill stepfather.
Minor has used marijuana for years. No exposure to domestic violence reported. Minor is failing in school. He leaves and comes home when he wants.
