Legislative Updates

- Sealing and Destruction of Records
- W&I 781
- Beginning January 1, 2015, the Juvenile Court and Probation shall ensure information about eligibility & procedures for sealing/destroying records shall be provided to minors w/ petitions filed or who are taken to probation pursuant to W&I 626

Legislative Updates

- Designation of Gang Member/Associate
- PC 186.34
- Prior to local LEA designating, or submitting to docs to AG's Office to designate, minor a gang member/associate, the LEA must provide written notice to minor and parents. They may then submit written doc to contest; LEA must provide verification w/in 60 days.

Legislative Updates

- Vandalism Probation Condition for Community Service
- PC 594.6
- Probation condition requiring up to 300 hours of PSW for any vandalism/graffiti offense may now be completed over a one year period (rather than 240 days)

Legislative Updates

- Youthful Offender Parole Hearing
- PC 3051
- Provides for parole hearings for prisoners under age of 18 at time of offense
 - If determinate sentence, eligible for release on parole during 15th year of incarceration
 - eligible for release on parole during 20th year of incarceration
 - If sentence is life term of 25 years to life, eligible for release on parole during 25th year of incarceration

- Board is to assess growth and maturity (psych evals & assessment tools can be used) and give great weight to diminished culpability of juveniles, features of youth, growth & maturity exhibited
- Family, friends, community can submit statements re: offender's growth and maturity since time of offense
- Hearing shall provide for "meaningful opportunity for release" (Board can consider other related topics consistent w/case law)
