Court of Appeal to Hold Special Session at University of Southern California

Los Angeles—The Court of Appeal, Second Appellate District, Division One, will hold oral argument at the University of Southern California (USC), Gould School of Law, on Tuesday, March 25, 2008, announced Acting Presiding Justice Robert Mallano.
