Symposium to Be Held on Courts' Web Site

Representatives from the Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC) and the California Judicial Center Library will present an update on using the Web site of the California judiciary on Tuesday, May 12, in Oakland.

The session, *Getting the Most From Courtinfo: The Web Site of the California Judiciary*, is the focus of the 12th annual Bernard E. Witkin Memorial Symposium. It will be held from 11:30 a.m. to 1 p.m. at the County of Alameda Conference Center in Oakland. One hour of MCLE credit is available.

Presented by the Witkin Legal Institute and the Bernard E. Witkin Alameda County Law Library, this year's symposium features speakers representing the AOC Information Services Division and Office of Communications and the California Judicial Center Library, the library of the California Supreme Court and the Court of Appeal, First Appellate District.

Presentations will focus on access to and practical use of the current Web sites and their information resources, as well as the sites' ongoing development, continuous improvement, and technical requirements. Audience comments and suggestions for Web site improvements are welcome as an important part of the program and discussion. The presenters are Michael Derr, Manager, and Mark Yuan, Supervising Information Services Analyst, Information Services Division; Mark Gelade, Supervisor, Web Communications Group; and Frances Jones, Director, California Judicial Center Library.

The program is designed for lawyers, judges, and other legal professionals as well as librarians and other information professionals, but is also open to the media and the public.
