San Jose—The Court of Appeal, Sixth Appellate District, will hold oral argument in the new Watsonville courthouse on Tuesday, May 13, 2008, announced Administrative Presiding Justice Conrad Lee Rushing. The session will begin at 9:30 a.m. at One Second Street in Watsonville.

The public is invited to attend the oral argument. Cases to be argued include Santa Cruz cases raising interesting issues in civil and criminal law.

The Sixth Appellate District has held argument in Santa Cruz County biannually since the court opened in 1984. The court ordinarily sits in San Jose. The court also holds argument at the Santa Clara University School of Law and in Monterey County.
