## News Conference Tomorrow on State Foster Care Reform

### ***Supreme Court Justice Carlos R. Moreno to Present Final Recommendations on Children in Foster Care***

San Francisco—The California Blue Ribbon Commission on Children in Foster Care will present its final recommendations on foster care reform to the Judicial Council tomorrow, August 15, at about 11:45 a.m., at its public business meeting at 455 Golden Gate Avenue.

Commission chair and Supreme Court Justice Carlos R. Moreno will submit the recommendations and ask the Judicial Council to take action on what are expected to be sweeping reforms of the state's juvenile dependency court system. A news conference will follow at about 12:15 p.m. in the Catalina Room.
