## **Court of Appeal Holds Special Session at Loyola Law School**

Los Angeles—Students from Loyola Law School will hear oral arguments before the Court of Appeal, Second Appellate District, Division Four, at 9 a.m. on September 17, 2009, Presiding Justice Norman L. Epstein announced today.

This visit is designed to introduce first-year law students to the appellate court system. “This is a major event for Loyola Law School and the students and faculty are very excited about the court’s visit. We expect a packed courtroom throughout the day,” said Loyola Law School Professor Laurie Levenson.

As part of this educational experience, the justices will attend a luncheon with students and faculty. This will allow the students the opportunity to talk with the Justices one-on-one about the judicial system.

September 17 is also Constitution Day.

The program arrangements are a collaborative effort of Presiding Justice Norman L. Epstein, Associate Justices Thomas Willhite, Jr., Nora M. Manella and Steven Suzukawa of the Court of Appeal, and Professor Levenson of Loyola Law School.
