Sixth Appellate District to Hold Oral Argument in Monterey County

San Jose—The Court of Appeal for the Sixth Appellate District, headquartered in San Jose, will hold oral argument in Monterey County on November 4, 2009, Presiding Justice Conrad L. Rushing has announced.

Oral arguments, primarily involving Monterey County cases, are scheduled to be heard starting at 9:30 a.m. in the Monterey County Board of Supervisors Chambers, 168 W. Alisal Street, Salinas.

The court holds oral argument in Monterey and Santa Cruz Counties biannually and at the Santa Clara University Law School annually as part of its outreach program. All proceedings are open to the public. The Sixth Appellate District comprises Monterey, San Benito, Santa Clara, and Santa Cruz counties.
