Ventura – As part of its award-winning community outreach program, the Ventura-based Division Six of the Court of Appeal, Second Appellate District, will hold oral argument at 1:30 p.m. on Wednesday, October 28, 2009, at the Santa Barbara County Board of Supervisors hearing room, 105 East Anapamu Street, fourth floor, Santa Barbara, Presiding Justice Arthur Gilbert has announced.

"Conducting argument in Santa Barbara has proven to be a very successful outreach program," said Presiding Justice Gilbert. "Holding argument in different venues enhances greater understanding of the appellate process. Traveling to Santa Barbara also provides greater access to our judicial system for plaintiffs, defendants, and lawyers living in the county."

Division Six includes Ventura, Santa Barbara and San Luis Obispo counties. This is the second time in 2009 that Division Six has heard oral argument away from its courtroom in Ventura, and is the tenth consecutive year that oral argument has been held in Santa Barbara. Division Six was the recipient of the Ralph M. Kleps Award in 2000. The cases to be heard follow:
