




# CIVIL GRAND JURY ON-LINE APPLICATION

## ABOUT

The Civil Grand Jury On-line Application is a technological solution that automates and streamlines the civil grand jury recruitment and statistical data collection processes for the Superior Court of California, County of Monterey and prospective civil grand jurors, including the managing of information about the civil grand jury, maintaining juror eligibility lists, performing functions for rating, selection, notification, mailings and producing contact lists for civil grand jurors.



Effectively uses the Internet to expand accessibility for the prospective grand juror to submit a statement of interest on-line from anywhere, anytime using the Internet.



Web-based on-line application for annually soliciting prospective candidates for the Civil Grand Jury.



Maintains grand jury data while automating and streamlining the end-to-end processes including updating an applicant's ranking and status throughout the selection process.



Enables the Court, in accordance with California Rule of Court 10.625, to maintain and publish annual summary demographics information for civil grand jurors.



Assists with the creation of mailing lists for applicant correspondence.



Provides a data mining tool which enhances the Court's ability to respond to the informational needs of the public and fosters a sense of openness and transparency to our diverse constituents.

- Leverages the Court's technological investment in the existing public website infrastructure


