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Sixth Appellate District Announces Destruction of Old Court Records

San Jose—The Court of Appeal for the Sixth Appellate District (San Jose) has announced its intention to destroy the following criminal, juvenile, and civil records pursuant to Rule 70(c), California Rules of Court:

- All criminal and juvenile cases designated in records transfer list 2, which have been preserved for more than 20 years.
- All civil cases designated in records transfer lists 46, 47, 51, 52, and box 70 of records transfer list 38, and boxes 27, 41, and 51 of records transfer list 44, which have been preserved for more than 10 years.

Anyone who knows of a reason why any of the above cases should be retained, whether for historical or other reasons, should notify Michael J. Yerly, Clerk/Administrator. The reasons for retention should be in writing, should be received by the court by February 17, 2006, and should be addressed to:
