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Fourth Appellate District Announces Destruction of Old Court Records

San Diego—The Court of Appeal, Fourth Appellate District, Division One (San Diego), has announced its intention to destroy the following criminal, juvenile, and civil records pursuant to Rule 10.1028(c), California Rules of Court.

The list of destroyed records encompasses criminal and juvenile records preserved for a period longer than 20 years and civil records preserved for a period longer than 10 years. All criminal and juvenile cases designated in the following storage numbers will be destroyed:
