## **Court of Appeal to Hold Public Outreach Session in San Luis Obispo**

Ventura—The Court of Appeal, Second Appellate District, Division Six, will hear oral argument on Wednesday, May 23, in San Luis Obispo, announced Presiding Justice Arthur Gilbert. The session, which is open to the public, will be held from 9:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. in the Board of Supervisors Hearing Room, 1055 Monterey Street.

This outreach program is designed to foster a better understanding of the appellate process. “After 21 years of outreach, San Luis Obispo has been a second home to Division Six,” stated Presiding Justice Gilbert. The majority of civil cases being argued in the division originate from San Luis Obispo County.

The mock trial team from Templeton High School has been invited to review the briefs of a selected case and discuss the issues with counsel following oral argument. When the opinion is filed, a copy will be sent to the mock trial coordinator. Reviewing the opinion helps students understand the issues and the legal reasoning used by the court in making its decision.
