## **Court of Appeal to Hear Oral Argument at Sacramento County High School**

Sacramento—As part of its award-winning outreach program, the Court of Appeal, Third Appellate District, will hear oral argument at a Sacramento County high school on Tuesday, October 24, Presiding Justice Arthur G. Scotland has announced.

The session will be held at San Juan High School, 7551 Greenback Lane, Citrus Heights, starting at 8:45 a.m.

During the past six years, the court has held sessions at high schools in these 14 counties within the district: Amador, Butte, El Dorado, Glenn, Mono, Nevada, Placer, Plumas, Sacramento, San Joaquin, Shasta, Tehama, Yolo, and Yuba.

As part of the educational program, justices of the Third Appellate District will participate in two question and answer sessions with the high school students on the court's appellate process and function.

Four cases will be heard, with three originating from Sacramento County and one from Placer County:

***In re Shannon T.***, Case No. C052035, Sacramento County. The minor appeals from a juvenile delinquency finding that he committed sexual battery.

***Barbara Tyler v. Unigard Insurance Company***, Case No. C052052, Placer County. Plaintiff Tyler appeals from an order granting defendant Unigard summary judgment on the ground that the undisputed facts establish she cannot prevail on her complaint alleging wrongful termination from employment and unlawful discrimination premised on disability.

***The People v. Dundell Wright***, Case No. C045750, Sacramento County. Defendant Wright appeals from judgment imposed upon a jury verdict finding that he murdered a Sacramento City police officer.

***Leila J. Levi v. Jack O'Connell, etc.***, C051722, Sacramento County. Plaintiff Levi appeals from dismissal of her complaint for failure to state a cause of action entitling her academically gifted son to judicial determination of his rights to a fair, equal, and funded education, including payment of expenses of education at a college and a university.

The Third Appellate District ordinarily holds oral argument at its courtroom in the Library and Courts Building, 914 Capitol Mall, Sacramento.

Twenty-three counties comprise the Third Appellate District: Alpine, Amador, Butte, Calaveras, Colusa, El Dorado, Glenn, Lassen, Modoc, Mono, Nevada, Placer, Plumas, Sacramento, San Joaquin, Shasta, Sierra, Siskiyou, Sutter, Tehama, Trinity, Yolo, and Yuba.
