Information for Potential Subcontractors and Suppliers for New San Bernardino Justice Center

What: A prequalification process takes place in June for potential construction subcontractors and suppliers interested in bidding to Rudolph and Sletten, Inc., the construction-manager-at-risk for the New San Bernardino Justice Center. Two meetings will provide information on the prequalification and bidding processes, timeline, scope, schedule, and other specifics and requirements.

Why: As construction-manager-at-risk under contract to the Administrative Office of the Courts for the New San Bernardino Justice Center, Rudolph and Sletten is performing outreach to ensure that local subcontractors have the information needed to enable them to participate in the prequalification process for construction work on this 384,000 square-foot courthouse for the Superior Court of San Bernardino County. The project site is at West Third Street and North Arrowhead Avenue in downtown San Bernardino. The current estimated construction cost is \$271 million. More information on the project:
