**Note: Differences between the CSR and WAFM filings can be due to the following factors**

1. Not all filing categories published in the CSR are included in the workload standards used in RAS and WAFM
2. Some of the filing data used in RAS needs to be reported by courts outside of the JBSIS reporting process, while the data published in the CSR is based on what is reported in JBSIS.
3. The snapshot of the data used in the WAFM calculation is a different point in time than when the final data is compiled for the CSR. Courts that regularly amend data may have different filing numbers in WAFM and the CSR depending on the timing of these data amendments.
