I have been a Judge of Los Angeles Superior Court for the last 31 years. I developed an automated and computerized jury instruction program. I negotiated a contract with the former West Publishing and then on behalf of the court sold the jury instruction program to West Publishing. This program known as the *California Jury Instruction Selector* is still sold by Thomson Reuters. I also developed an automated case management system that was used in the Northwest District for 10 years. I bring these matters to your attention not to boast of my achievements, but rather to indicate that I have sufficient experience with court operations to know what I'm talking about. In other words I did not exclusively try cases for 31 years, but also was involved in the management of court rooms and court administration.
