At the hearing, you can tell the judge that you do not want the orders against you. Even if you do not attend the hearing, you *must* obey the orders.

To the person in (1): At the hearing, the court will consider whether denial of any orders will jeopardize your safety and the safety of children for whom you are requesting custody, visitation, and child support. Safety concerns related to the financial needs of you and your children will also be considered.

Instructions for Law Enforcement

This Order is effective when made. It is enforceable anywhere in all 50 states, the District of Columbia, all tribal lands, and all U.S. territories and shall be enforced as if it were an Order of that jurisdiction by any law enforcement agency that has received the Order, is shown a copy of the Order, or has verified its existence. If the law enforcement agency has not received proof of service on the restrained person, and the restrained person was not present at the court hearing, the agency shall advise the restrained person of the terms of the Order and then shall enforce it. Violations of this restraining order are subject to criminal penalties.
