Court of Appeal Announces Destruction of Old Court Records

San Jose—The Court of Appeal, <u>Sixth Appellate District</u> (San Jose) has announced its intention to destroy the following criminal, juvenile, and civil records pursuant to Rule 10.1028(d), of the California Rules of Court.

All records in criminal and juvenile cases (excluding those with published opinions) are preserved for a period longer than 20 years, and all records in civil cases (excluding those with published opinions) are preserved for a period longer than 10 years.
