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1. The position description is not very clear. Do we need the architect level candidates or senior developers or lead level candidates?

**Answer:** Candidates must be at the architect level as set forth in 1.3.1 and 2.1 of the RFP and must have the experience set forth in 6.3.1.1 of the RFP.

2. Do all 4 need to be at the same level? Or one could be an architect, others could be senior developers

**Answer:** The level of all 4 will be architects.

3. The technologies listed are not clear. Can you please clarify what technologies are required versus nice to have.

**Answer:** All requirements under 6.3.1.1 are required. The technologies are listed in 6.3.1.1 subparagraphs l., m., and o., which are restated below:

- l. Knowledge of leading edge concepts in technology including: Operating Systems, Databases, Networking, Security, SOA, Middleware, BPM, DMS, Virtualization, SAN, and NAS.
- m. Provide advanced troubleshooting for complex issues in web applications developed using technologies including: Apache, JBoss, WebLogic, Oracle DB, PervasiveSQL, SiteMinder, Crystal Reports, Citrix, ColdFusion, TIBCO Portal and TIBCO middleware.
- o. Experience in programming languages including C, C++, Java and SQL.

Requirements under 6.3.1.2 are highly desirable.
