This case presents the following issues: (1) Must a newly incorporated city approve a final subdivision map if the county previously approved a tentative map? (2) Is a newly incorporated city estopped from disapproving a tentative map previously approved by the county if the city adopted the county ordinance requiring approval of the final map, exempted the project from a development moratorium, and worked with the developer to clear conditions?
