

**How to Transmit
Documents Related to Health and Safety Code §115800
Regarding Known or Reported Injuries Incurred by Skateboarders
In a Public Skateboard Park or Facility**

Health and Safety Code §115800 requires that “The appropriate local public agency shall maintain a record of all known or reported injuries incurred by a skateboarder in a public skateboard park or facility. *The local public agency shall also maintain a record of all claims, paid and not paid, including any lawsuits and their results, arising from those incidents that were filed against the public agency*” (emphasis added). These **public agencies** are required in turn to report annually to the Judicial Council by submitting copies of these records.

The next deadline for submitting these records covering the calendar year 2006 is January 31, 2007. Please note that as of January 1, 2001, **this requirement pertains to public skateboard parks constructed after January 1, 1998 only.**

This legislation does not require, nor will the Judicial Council accept, reports from individuals who may have been injured in skateboarding accidents on public property.
