1. All capitalized terms not defined in this amendment (the "Amendment") have the meanings given to them in the Agreement referenced above. As set forth in the Agreement, (the "Master Agreement"), the term "Contractor" refers to **StopTech Ltd.**, and the term "AOC" refers to the Judicial Council of California, Administrative Office of the Courts.



2. The title of this Master Agreement is: non-exclusive services, equipment, software, and hardware in connection with the purchase, installation and configuration of wireless security systems and/or the purchase and configuration of mobile security systems at specified Courts throughout California, on an as-needed basis to Members of the Purchasing Group
The title listed above is for administrative reference only and does not define, limit, or construe the scope or extent of the Agreement.

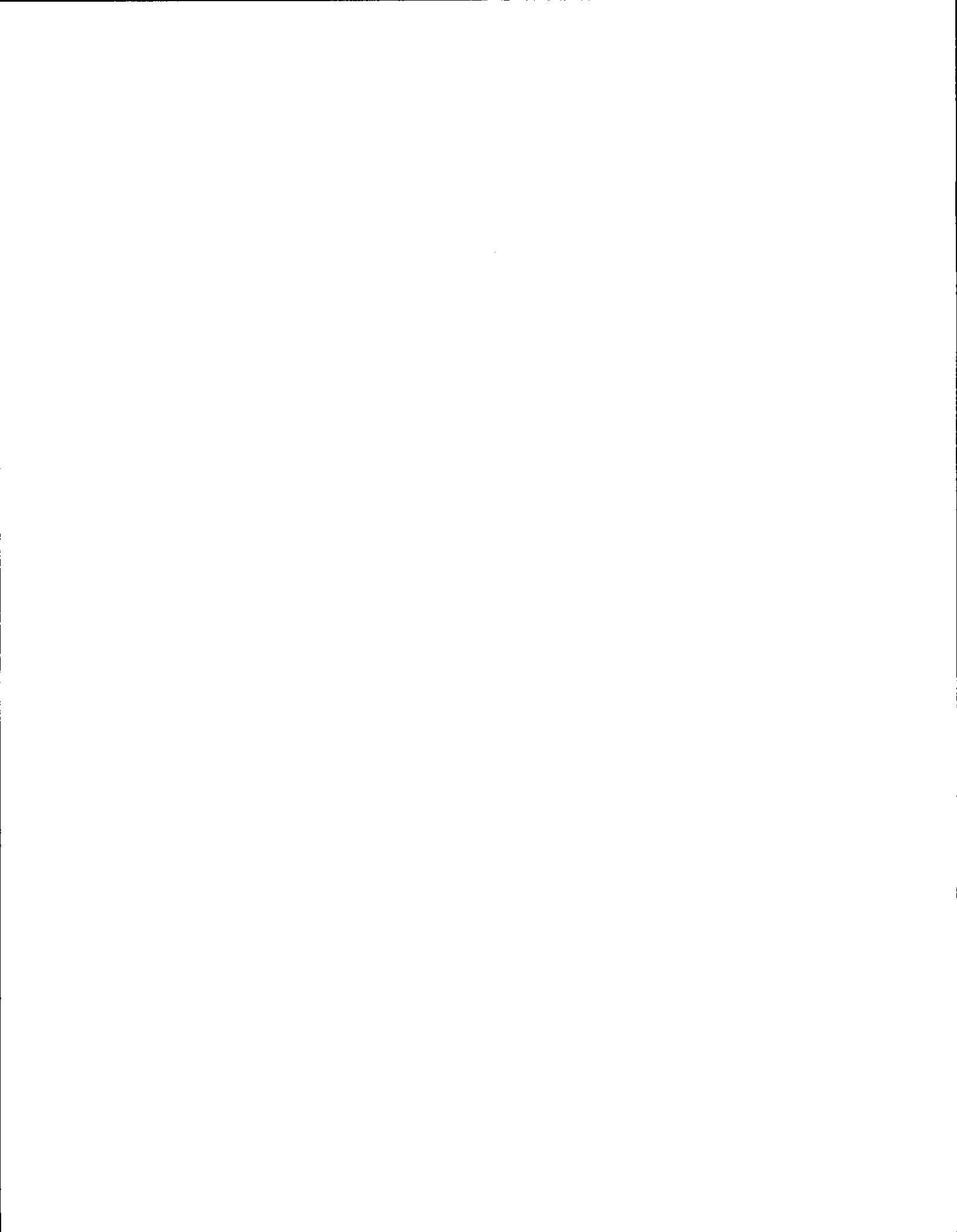
3. This Amendment becomes effective on **May 1, 2013** and expires **April 30, 2014**.

4. The maximum amount that the AOC may pay Contractor under this Master Agreement (as amended) remains unchanged at **\$00.00**.

5. The parties agree to amend the Master Agreement as follows:
 - a. Pursuant to Exhibit B, Special Provisions, paragraph 6, Master Agreement Term and Options to Renew, the AOC hereby exercises its option to extend this Master Agreement for the Third Option Term period beginning **May 1, 2013** and ending **April 30, 2014**. Unless the AOC exercises its Fourth Option Term, the Agreement shall expire **April 30, 2014**.
 - b. Exhibit B, Special Provisions, Paragraph No. 7, Agreement Administration/Communication is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with Exhibit B, Special Provisions, Paragraph No. 7, attached hereto and incorporated herewith.
 - c. Effective **May 1, 2013**, Exhibit E, Product Specifications, is hereby appended with Exhibit E, Product Specifications, Appendix No. 1, attached hereto.
 - d. Exhibit F, Attachment 2, Revision No. 3, Sample Centurion Wireless Security System Work Order Form is hereby incorporated into this Master Agreement for use effective **May 1, 2013**.
 - e. Exhibit F, Attachment 3, Revision No. 2, Sample Centurion Scout Mobile Security System Work Order Form is hereby incorporated into this Master Agreement for use effective **May 1, 2013**.
 - f. Exhibit F, Attachment 4, Pricing Schedule, Revision No. 3 is hereby appended with Exhibit F, Attachment 4, Pricing Schedule, Appendix No. 1 to Revision No. 3, effective **May 1, 2013 to April 30, 2014**.

6. Except as provided in this Amendment, all terms and conditions of the original Agreement remain in full force and effect.

The Member’s Project Manager will consult with any designee(s) to determine if the Contractor has satisfactorily performed the Work in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Agreement.

APPENDIX NO. 1 [New]
Effective May 1, 2013

The following specifications append Exhibit E, Product Specifications and are applicable to purchases of Centurion® Wireless Security Systems or Centurion Scout® Mobile Security Systems on or after May 1, 2013:

Wireless Duress/Panic Alarm System

The alarm system must have the following features and specifications:

1. System capable of broadcasting 255 unique location specific messages, in a single stand-alone wireless unit, with an unlimited number of addressable sensors.
2. 386ex based System Platform which enables immediate alarm processing.
3. Internal MultiTech Systems Voice Modem model # MT5656SMI; capable of sending location specific voice to any phone. (Land line or Cell Phone). Must be capable of sending voice alarm to 8 unique phone numbers.
4. System must have the ability to utilize EchoStream (ES) transmission formats.
5. System must have Fail Safe System Monitor:
 - Recognizes and Reboots system if anomaly occurs
 - Displays Fail Safe Monitor failure warnings on LCD
 - Sounds audible alarm if Fail Safe Monitor failure occurs
6. Integrated Total Protection Solutions LT-15A Surge Protector.
7. System must have priority transmission settings (radio/phone/text) per sensor.
8. System must be able to schedule transmissions automatically to broadcast on differing devices (Radio 1, Radio 2, Cell Phone, Pager) dependant upon the time of day.
9. System must allow different communication paths to be programmed for each sensor:
 - Panic button #1 sends alert to Officer's cell phone
 - Panic button #2 sends alert to Officer's two way radio

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10. System must offer Voice Modem Repeat: the ability to select how many times a message will repeat, separate from other outputs (i.e., Radio message repeats two times and phone message repeats six times).
11. Ability to interface with any existing radio system: UHF, VHF, 800 and 900 MHz and any trunking system.
12. Email notification of Alarm History Log.
13. Email/text messaging by Ethernet Interface to desktop, cell phone, pager, or other text capable devices.
14. Minimum of 1980 seconds of message record time in a single, stand-alone unit.
15. Sensor Signal Monitoring System:
 - Sensor "tamper", "low battery" and "missing" events are monitored and recorded in Alarm History Log.
 - Continuous "signal strength level" monitoring of events can be displayed on LCD; providing assurance of System sensor monitoring performance.
16. Flexible scheduling of sensor zones that allow for automatic enabling and disabling based on user defined schedules: minute, hour and day of the week.
17. Remote access capable - Internal Modem to allow authorized technician to access the system remotely in order to:
 - Expand the number of messages as system requirements increase.
 - Perform operating system diagnostics.
 - Upgrade operating software.
18. Voice prompts for system activation and set-up.
19. Built-in microphone/speaker to record voice messages and playback. The speaker can also be used as an output device which allows the user to select and prioritize the speaker to be used for output of audio as well as volume control.
20. Four (4) internal Communication Ports, that are available to connect to an external PC in order to monitor alarms, view and print event log, engage system setup/configuration and forward of emergency text notifications.
21. System must have the ability to interface with the WaveWare® Pager System.
22. Communication Ports must include:
 - Serial

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- USB
 - Ethernet
 - Modem
23. Built-in DTMF Tone Encoder.
24. Capable of handling a full-line of wireless, 900 MHz sensors.
25. Designed to interface a second radio.
- Mounting space, electrical cabling and connectors are available to operate a second radio simultaneously at a different frequency than the primary radio.
26. System must be password protected.
27. Onboard programming of system and sensors (no external keyboard or programming device required).
28. Message Dwell Time: Upon alarm activation, the system will “dwell” for 15 seconds any alarm triggers which share the same message.
29. The alarm system must be – FCC Class A&B Digital Device (company must provide verification documents) Verification Compliant – Title 47 of the CFR (Code of Federal Regulation), Part 15, Subpart B:
- 15.107 (a) – Emission Limits.
 - 15.109 (b) – Radiated Limits.
30. Battery back-up that can continue system operation for 30 hours in the event of a power outage.
31. Capable of broadcasting a message indicating that battery back-up failure is imminent and the system is shutting down.
32. The system must protect the battery from full discharge.
33. Battery charging system that charges the internal battery during 110V operation.
34. Four (4) programmable relays that are available to activate external devices such as video cameras, lights, alarms, etc.
35. Alarm history storage of the last 200 alarms in a circular nonvolatile buffer for review or printing.
36. Control panel with a plain English LCD display including 4 lines with 20 characters per line.

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37. Full-function 16-key keypad.

38. LCD Status Indicators that provide the following information:

- Power Source – Indicates the type of system power (AC, DC).
- Battery Status – Indicates the battery condition (charged, charging or low battery).
- System Status – Armed or Disarmed.
- System Unit # – Indicates unique identification for every system.
- Sensor Number – Indicates which sensor has been activated.
- Log – Indicates that an event has occurred since last viewing the Alarm Log.

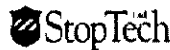

C. **Price for Installation.** For the complete installation of each Centurion Wireless Security System, the AOC will pay the Contractor a flat standard installation/training charge of **\$1,800.00**, inclusive of the time (up to 8 productive hours), labor, and travel expenses, including related per diem, necessary for the Contractor's factory-authorized technician to perform all required Tasks to install such system at the installation Site, including the following:

- i. Configuration and physical installation of the central control unit, and all applicable duress buttons, repeaters (signal boosters), and/or other sensors and equipment.
- ii. System testing and analysis.
- iii. Confirmation of RF communication (message clarity, signal strength).

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- iv. Training, including instruction on day-to-day operation, preventative maintenance, and system features and capabilities.
- D. **Miscellaneous Charges.** The Member will pay the Contractor for any applicable State of California or local sales or use taxes on the services rendered or equipment or component parts supplied pursuant to this Master Agreement. If authorized in a Work Order, the Member will also pay the Contractor for the following charges: delivery, drayage, express, parcel post, packing, cartage, insurance, license fees, permits, and cost of bonds.
- E. **Pricing for Extending Limited Warranty.**
- i. Pricing for extending the period of the Contractor's limited warranty for each Centurion Wireless Security System purchased and installed pursuant to this Master Agreement, beyond the initial two (2) year period commencing upon Acceptance, as further set forth in paragraphs 29.B. of Exhibit B, Special Provisions, is set forth in Table 2, below, inclusive of software updates, parts, and labor, but exclusive of radios, sensors, repeaters, receivers, and travel-related expenses, including per diem.
 - ii. Pricing for extending the period of the Contractor's limited warranty for each Centurion Scout® Mobile Security System purchased and installed pursuant to this Master Agreement, beyond the initial one (1) year period commencing upon Acceptance, as further set forth in paragraphs 29.C. of Exhibit B, Special Provisions, is set forth in Table 2, below, inclusive of software updates, parts, and labor, but exclusive of radios, sensors, repeaters, receivers, and travel-related expenses, including per diem.
 - iii. The base cost for extending the period of the limited warranty starts at **\$300.00** per year or at **\$25.00** per month for 0-8 messages, and increases for each additional message thereafter, as further illustrated by Table 2, below.

- F. **Price for Service Not Covered by Limited Warranty.** Pursuant to a Work Order, the Member shall reimburse the Contractor at the rate of **\$80.00** per hour to provide service at a Site or at the Contractor's manufacturing facility, which is not covered under the provisions of limited warranty or standard installation/training, as set forth in paragraph 29 of Exhibit B, Special Provisions and paragraph C of this Exhibit F, Price for Installation.
- G. **Meals and Lodging expenses.** As set forth in Exhibit C, paragraph 3, Allowable Expenses, the Member shall reimburse the Contractor for overnight travel, in accordance with the California Victim Compensation and Government Claims Board (formerly State Board of Control) guidelines, for reasonable actual meal and lodging expenses. Meals shall be reimbursed at the actual cost not to exceed the following maximum amounts per person per Day: breakfast~**\$6.00**; lunch~**\$10.00**; dinner~**\$18.00**; and/or incidentals~**\$6.00**. Hotel room rental shall be reimbursed for the actual cost not to exceed **\$110.00** per Day, plus tax and energy surcharge, when applicable, or **\$140.00** per Day, plus tax and energy surcharge, when applicable, in the counties of Alameda, San Francisco, San Mateo, and Santa Clara.
