Dear Senator Mitchell, Assembly Member Ting, and Mr. Cohen:

The Judicial Council respectfully submits this report, as required by Government Code section 68502.6, concerning cash flow loans made to trial courts in fiscal year (FY) 2016–2017 under the same code section.

In fiscal year 2016–2017, 58 trial courts, as a result of a delay in receiving quarterly revenues at the state level, received \$39 million in cash flow loans from the Judicial Branch Workers' Compensation Fund and \$40 million from the Immediate and Critical Needs Account within the State Court Facilities Construction Fund for a total of \$79 million to the Trial Court Trust Fund. These loans were essential to the courts' efforts in meeting their operational demands, including meeting payroll obligations. The attached report provides the list of
