Dear Ms. Boyer-Vine, Ms. Contreras, and Ms. Parker:

Pursuant to Government Code section 70352(c), the Judicial Council is submitting the report on the actual expenditures of the Court Facilities Trust Fund for fiscal year 2018-19.

Government Code section 70352(b) states, "Money deposited in [the Court Facilities Trust Fund] and appropriated by the Legislature shall be administered by the Judicial Council for the operation, repair, and maintenance of court facilities and other purposes provided by statute." In 2018–19, the fund expended \$106,590,140 for the purposes shown in the table below.
