HOLLAND ON DISCIPLINE

Recommended discipline imposed

The court orders that JAMES CURTIS HOLLAND, State Bar Number 134233, is suspended from the practice of law in California for one year, execution of that period of suspension is stayed, and he is placed on probation for one year subject to the following conditions:

1. JAMES CURTIS HOLLAND is suspended from the practice of law for the first 30 days of probation;
2. JAMES CURTIS HOLLAND must comply with the other conditions of probation recommended by the Hearing Department of the State Bar Court in its Decision filed on November 18, 2014; and
3. At the expiration of the period of probation, if JAMES CURTIS HOLLAND has complied with all conditions of probation, the one-year period of stayed suspension will be satisfied and that suspension will be terminated.

JAMES CURTIS HOLLAND must also take and pass the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination within one year after the effective date of this order and provide satisfactory proof of such passage to the State Bar's Office of Probation in Los Angeles within the same period.

Failure to do so may result in suspension. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(b).)

Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

Recommended discipline imposed

The court orders that MICHAEL LEE GOOLSBY, State Bar Number 159660, is suspended from the practice of law in California for one year, execution of that period of suspension is stayed, and he is placed on probation for one year subject to the following conditions:

1. MICHAEL LEE GOOLSBY must comply with the conditions of probation recommended by the Hearing Department of the State Bar Court in its Order Approving Stipulation filed on November 18, 2014; and
2. At the expiration of the period of probation, if MICHAEL LEE GOOLSBY has complied with the terms of probation, the period of stayed suspension will be satisfied and that suspension will be terminated.

Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment. One-third of the costs must be paid with his membership fees for each of the years 2016, 2017, and 2018. 1. TERENCE TYRONE HALLINAN is suspended from the practice of law for the first 90 days of probation;
2. TERENCE TYRONE HALLINAN must comply with the other conditions of probation recommended by the Hearing Department of the State Bar Court in its Order Approving Stipulation filed on November 19, 2014; and
3. At the expiration of the period of probation, if TERENCE TYRONE HALLINAN has complied with all conditions of probation, the period of stayed suspension will be satisfied and that suspension will be terminated.

TERENCE TYRONE HALLINAN must also take and pass the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination within one year after the effective date of this order and provide satisfactory proof of such passage to the State Bar's Office of Probation in Los Angeles within the same period. Failure to do so may result in suspension. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(b).) TERENCE TYRONE HALLINAN must also comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 calendar days, respectively, after the effective date of this order. Failure to do so may result in disbarment or suspension.

Recommended discipline imposed: disbarred

The court orders that LISA R. ALEXHOLLAND, State Bar Number 224000, is disbarred from the practice of law in California and that her name is stricken from the roll of attorneys.

LISA R. ALEXHOLLAND must also comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 calendar days, respectively, after the effective date of this order.

Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

Recommended discipline imposed

The court orders that PATRICK THOMAS SANTOS, State Bar Number 265982, is suspended from the practice of law in California for two years, execution of that period of suspension is stayed, and he is placed on probation for two years subject to the following conditions:

1. PATRICK THOMAS SANTOS is suspended from the practice of law for the first 30 days of probation;
2. PATRICK THOMAS SANTOS must comply with the other conditions of probation recommended by the Hearing Department of the State Bar Court in its Order Approving Stipulation filed on November 21, 2014; and
3. At the expiration of the period of probation, if PATRICK THOMAS SANTOS has complied with all conditions of probation, the period of stayed suspension will be satisfied and that suspension will be terminated.

If PATRICK THOMAS SANTOS fails to pay any installment as described above, or as may be modified by the State Bar Court, the remaining balance is due and payable immediately.

Recommended discipline imposed

The court orders that G. CAT STOKES, State Bar Number 112473, is suspended from the practice of law in California for two years, execution of that period of suspension is stayed, and he is placed on probation for two years subject to the following conditions:

1. G. CAT STOKES is suspended from the practice of law for the first six months of probation;
2. G. CAT STOKES must comply with the other conditions of probation recommended by the Hearing Department of the State Bar Court in its Order Approving Stipulation filed on November 20, 2014; and
3. At the expiration of the period of probation, if G. CAT STOKES has complied with all conditions of probation, the period of stayed suspension will be satisfied and that suspension will be terminated.

G. CAT STOKES must also take and pass the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination within one year after the effective date of this order and provide satisfactory proof of such passage to the State Bar's Office of Probation in Los Angeles within the same period. Failure to do so may result in suspension. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(b).)

CAT STOKES must also comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 calendar days, respectively, after the effective date of this order. S224063**LYNES ON DISCIPLINE**

Recommended discipline imposed: disbarred

The court orders that STEVEN CHARLES LYNES, State Bar Number 174020, is disbarred from the practice of law in California and that his name is stricken from the roll of attorneys.

STEVEN CHARLES LYNES must make restitution to the following payees:

- (1) Lynda Youmans in the amount of \$1,300 plus 10 percent interest per year from May 21, 2012;
- (2) Yolanda Williams in the amount of \$2,000 plus 10 percent interest per year from August 1, 2012; and
- (3) Donald and Lillian Prater in the amount of \$2,600 plus 10 percent interest per year from January 9, 2013.

Any restitution owed to the Client Security Fund is enforceable as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.5, subdivisions (c) and (d).

STEVEN CHARLES LYNES must also comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 calendar days, respectively, after the effective date of this order.

Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

S224064**LEE ON DISCIPLINE**

Recommended discipline imposed: disbarred

The court orders that MELISSA SOYOUNG LEE, State Bar Number 195720, is disbarred from the practice of law in California and that her name is stricken from the roll of attorneys.

MELISSA SOYOUNG LEE must also comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 calendar days, respectively, after the effective date of this order.

Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

Recommended discipline imposed

1. ROBERT DUANE KAWAMURA is suspended from the practice of law for the first 90 days of probation;
2. ROBERT DUANE KAWAMURA must comply with the other conditions of probation recommended by the Hearing Department of the State Bar Court in its Order Approving Stipulation filed on November 21, 2014; and
3. At the expiration of the period of probation, if ROBERT DUANE KAWAMURA has complied with all conditions of probation, the period of stayed suspension will be satisfied and that suspension will be terminated.

ROBERT DUANE KAWAMURA must also take and pass the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination within one year after the effective date of this order and provide satisfactory proof of such passage to the State Bar's Office of Probation in Los Angeles within the same period. Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

Recommended discipline imposed

The court orders that ANDREW NICHOLAS DIMITRIOU, State Bar Number 187733, is suspended from the practice of law in California for two years, execution of that period of suspension is stayed, and he is placed on probation for three years subject to the following conditions:

1. ANDREW NICHOLAS DIMITRIOU is suspended from the practice of law for the first year of probation;
2. ANDREW NICHOLAS DIMITRIOU must comply with the other conditions of probation recommended by the Hearing Department of the State Bar Court in its Order Approving Stipulation filed on November 13, 2014; and
3. At the expiration of the period of probation, if ANDREW NICHOLAS DIMITRIOU has complied with all conditions of probation, the period of stayed suspension will be satisfied and that suspension will be terminated.

ANDREW NICHOLAS DIMITRIOU must also take and pass the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination within one year after the effective date of this order and provide satisfactory proof of such passage to the State Bar's Office of Probation in Los Angeles within the same period. Failure to do so may result in suspension. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(b).)

Recommended discipline imposed

1. JAMES BERNARD DOWLING is suspended from the practice of law for the first 30 days of probation;
2. JAMES BERNARD DOWLING must comply with the other conditions of probation recommended by the Hearing Department of the State Bar Court in its Order Approving Stipulation filed on November 17, 2014; and
3. At the expiration of the period of probation, if JAMES BERNARD DOWLING has complied with all conditions of probation, the one-year period of stayed suspension will be satisfied and that suspension will be terminated.

JAMES BERNARD DOWLING must also take and pass the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination within one year after the effective date of this order and provide satisfactory proof of such passage to the State Bar's Office of Probation in Los Angeles within the same period. Failure to do so may result in suspension. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(b).) Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment. One-third of the costs must be paid with his membership fees for each of the years 2016, 2017, and 2018. Recommended discipline imposed: disbarred

The court orders that ROBERT EMMETT MEYER, State Bar Number 102514, is disbarred from the practice of law in California and that his name is stricken from the roll of attorneys.

ROBERT EMMETT MEYER must also comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 calendar days, respectively, after the effective date of this order.

Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

S224224**MORSE ON DISCIPLINE**

Recommended discipline imposed: disbarred

The court orders that CARLTON NEIL MORSE, State Bar Number 254106, is summarily disbarred from the practice of law and that his name is stricken from the roll of attorneys.

CARLTON NEIL MORSE must also comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 calendar days, respectively, after the effective date of this order.

Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

S224230**ROSIN ON DISCIPLINE**

Recommended discipline imposed: disbarred

The court orders that ANITA D. ROSIN, State Bar Number 198496, is disbarred from the practice of law in California and that her name is stricken from the roll of attorneys.

ANITA D. ROSIN must make payment to Client Security Fund in the amount of \$12,152.96 plus 10 percent interest per year from October 26, 2011. Any restitution owed to the Client Security Fund is enforceable as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.5, subdivisions (c) and (d).

ANITA D. ROSIN must also comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 calendar days, respectively, after the effective date of this order.

Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.
