Extension of time granted

Good cause appearing, and based upon Senior Deputy State Public Defender Marianne D. Bachers's representation that the appellant's reply brief is anticipated to be filed by April 11, 2017, counsel's request for an extension of time in which to file that brief is granted to October 11, 2016. After that date, only three further extensions totaling about 184 additional days are contemplated.
