SHAFER ON DISCIPLINE

Recommended discipline imposed

The court orders that DAVID ALAN SHAFER, State Bar Number 86436, is suspended from the practice of law in California for two years, execution of that period of suspension is stayed, and he is placed on probation for two years subject to the following conditions:

- 1. DAVID ALAN SHAFER is suspended from the practice of law for the first 60 days of probation;
- 2. DAVID ALAN SHAFER must comply with the other conditions of probation recommended by the Review Department of the State Bar Court in its Opinion filed on February 15, 2018; and
- 3. At the expiration of the period of probation, if DAVID ALAN SHAFER has complied with all conditions of probation, the period of stayed suspension will be satisfied and that suspension will be terminated.

Failure to do so may result in suspension. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(b).) Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.
