The court orders that BRANDON BURNHAM POWELL, State Bar Number 167740, is disbarred from the practice of law in California and that his name is stricken from the roll of attorneys. BRANDON BURNHAM POWELL must also comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 calendar days, respectively, after the effective date of this order.

Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

Recommended discipline imposed: disbarred

The court orders that JAMES DARRYL IVEY, State Bar Number 154832, is disbarred from the practice of law in California and that his name is stricken from the roll of attorneys.

JAMES DARRYL IVEY must also comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 calendar days, respectively, after the effective date of this order.

Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

**S226111****COOMBS ON DISCIPLINE**

Recommended discipline imposed

The court orders that RICHARD EDWARD COOMBS, State Bar Number 74281, is suspended from the practice of law in California for one year, execution of that period of suspension is stayed, and he is placed on probation for two years subject to the following conditions:

1. RICHARD EDWARD COOMBS must comply with the conditions of probation recommended by the Hearing Department of the State Bar Court in its Order Approving Stipulation filed on March 6, 2015; and
2. At the expiration of the period of probation, if RICHARD EDWARD COOMBS has complied with the terms of probation, the one-year period of stayed suspension will be satisfied and that suspension will be terminated.

RICHARD EDWARD COOMBS must also take and pass the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination within one year after the effective date of this order and provide satisfactory proof of such passage to the State Bar's Office of Probation within the same period. Failure to do so may result in suspension. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(b).)

Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment. One-half of the costs must be paid with his membership fees for each of the years 2016 and 2017. If RICHARD EDWARD COOMBS fails to pay any installment as described above, or as may be modified by the State Bar Court, the remaining balance is due and payable immediately.

**S226123****WENZEL ON DISCIPLINE**

Recommended discipline imposed

The court orders that MARK DANIEL WENZEL, State Bar Number 96673, is suspended from the practice of law in California for two years, execution of that period of suspension is stayed, and he is placed on probation for three years subject to the following conditions:

1. MARK DANIEL WENZEL is suspended from the practice of law for a minimum of the first two years of probation, and he will remain suspended until he provides proof to the State Bar Court of his rehabilitation, fitness to practice and learning and ability in the general law. (Rules Proc. of State Bar, tit. IV, Stds. for Atty. Sanctions for Prof. Misconduct, std. 1.2(c)(1).)
2. MARK DANIEL WENZEL must also comply with the other conditions of probation recommended by the Review Department of the State Bar Court in its Opinion filed on January 26, 2015.
3. At the expiration of the period of probation, if MARK DANIEL WENZEL has complied with all conditions of probation, the period of stayed suspension will be satisfied and that suspension will be terminated.

MARK DANIEL WENZEL must also take and pass the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination during the period of his suspension and provide satisfactory proof of such passage to the State Bar's Office of Probation in Los Angeles within the same period. Failure to do so may result in suspension. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(b).)

MARK DANIEL WENZEL must also comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 calendar days, respectively, after the effective date of this order. Failure to do so may result in disbarment or suspension.
