- 2. What evidence, other than the Mason sexual offenses, would support a jury finding that defendant entered Myers's home with the intent to commit a sexual offense? (See *People v. Falsetta* (1999) 21 Cal.4th 903, 920, 923.)
- 3. Assuming defendant was accused of a sexual offense against Myers, would the trial court have been required to exclude evidence of the Mason sexual offenses under Evidence Code section 352 in a separate trial of the Myers charges? (*Falsetta*, *supra*, 21 Cal.4th at pp. 916-919.)
- 4. Do the provisions of Evidence Code section 1108 provide a basis to uphold the trial court's denial of defendant's motion to sever the Mason charges from the Myers charges?

The parties are directed to serve and file simultaneous letter briefs addressing these questions on or before June 19, 2015. The parties may serve and file simultaneous reply briefs within seven days after the initial supplemental brief that is or could be timely filed under this or any subsequent order of this court. No extension of time for the filing of these briefs is contemplated.
