Petition stricken (case closed)

The petition for review filed by appellant on August 29, 2017, is hereby ordered stricken pursuant to the order from the Court of Appeal, Second Appellate District granting appellant's petition for rehearing issued on August 16, 2017.

Extension of time granted

Good cause appearing, and based upon counsel Phillip H. Cherney's representation that the appellant's opening brief is anticipated to be filed by December 18, 2017, an extension of time in which to file that brief is granted to December 1, 2017. After that date, only one further extension totaling about 16 additional days is contemplated.

An application to file an overlength brief must be served and filed no later than 60 days before the anticipated filing date. (See Cal. Rules of Court, rule 8.631(d)(1)(A)(ii) & (B)(ii).)

S243402 **DURST ON DISCIPLINE**

Recommended discipline imposed: disbarred

The court orders that LEE HUMPHREY DURST, State Bar Number 69704, is disbarred from the practice of law in California and that his name is stricken from the roll of attorneys.

LEE HUMPHREY DURST must also comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 calendar days, respectively, after the effective date of this order.

Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

S243405**FLETCHER ON DISCIPLINE**

Recommended discipline imposed

The court orders that CHARLES JEFFREY FLETCHER, State Bar Number 142464, is suspended from the practice of law in California for one year, execution of that period of suspension is stayed, and he is placed on probation for one year subject to the following conditions:

1. CHARLES JEFFREY FLETCHER is suspended from the practice of law for the first 60 days of probation;
2. CHARLES JEFFREY FLETCHER must comply with the other conditions of probation recommended by the Hearing Department of the State Bar Court in its Order Approving Stipulation filed on June 9, 2017; and
3. At the expiration of the period of probation, if CHARLES JEFFREY FLETCHER has complied with all conditions of probation, the period of stayed suspension will be satisfied and that suspension will be terminated.

Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

S243408**GOODRICH ON DISCIPLINE**

Recommended discipline imposed: disbarred

The court orders that WILLIAM DENNETT GOODRICH, State Bar Number 119144, is disbarred from the practice of law in California and that his name is stricken from the roll of attorneys.

WILLIAM DENNETT GOODRICH must make restitution to the following payees:

- (1) Cindy Sinsky and Ed Sinsky in the amount of \$3,500 plus 10 percent interest per year from May 19, 2011; and
- (2) Jamie Glass in the amount of \$2,500 plus 10 percent interest per year from September 28, 2011.

Any restitution owed to the Client Security Fund is enforceable as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.5, subdivisions (c) and (d).

WILLIAM DENNETT GOODRICH must also comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 calendar days, respectively, after the effective date of this order.

Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

S243410**KOP ON DISCIPLINE**

Recommended discipline imposed

The court orders that STEVEN KARLTON WEN-HAO KOP, State Bar Number 91354, is suspended from the practice of law in California for two years, execution of that period of suspension is stayed, and he is placed on probation for two years' subject to the following conditions:

1. STEVEN KARLTON WEN-HAO KOP is suspended from the practice of law for the first six months of probation;
2. STEVEN KARLTON WEN-HAO KOP must comply with the other conditions of probation recommended by the Hearing Department of the State Bar Court in its Order Approving Stipulation filed on June 16, 2017; and
3. At the expiration of the period of probation, if STEVEN KARLTON WEN-HAO KOP has complied with all conditions of probation, the period of stayed suspension will be satisfied and that suspension will be terminated.

STEVEN KARLTON WEN-HAO KOP must also take and pass the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination within one year after the effective date of this order and provide satisfactory proof of such passage to the State Bar's Office of Probation in Los Angeles within the same period. Failure to do so may result in suspension. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(b).)

STEVEN KARLTON WEN-HAO KOP must also comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20 and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 calendar days, respectively, after the effective date of this order. Failure to do so may result in disbarment or suspension.

Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

DISCIPLINE**

Recommended discipline imposed: disbarred

The court orders that JOHN DARWIN McCURDY II, State Bar Number 54091, is disbarred from the practice of law in California and that his name is stricken from the roll of attorneys.

JOHN DARWIN McCURDY II must also comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 calendar days, respectively, after the effective date of this order.

Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

S243418**MAS ON DISCIPLINE**

Recommended discipline imposed

The court orders that GLORIA MARIA MAS, State Bar Number 132429, is suspended from the practice of law in California for two years, execution of that period of suspension is stayed, and she is placed on probation for three years' subject to the following conditions:

1. GLORIA MARIA MAS is suspended from the practice of law for the first sixty days of probation;
2. GLORIA MARIA MAS must comply with the other conditions of probation recommended by the Hearing Department of the State Bar Court in its Order Approving Stipulation filed on June 5, 2017; and
3. At the expiration of the period of probation, if GLORIA MARIA MAS has complied with all conditions of probation, the period of stayed suspension will be satisfied and that suspension will be terminated.

GLORIA MARIA MAS must also take and pass the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination within one year after the effective date of this order and provide satisfactory proof of such passage to the State Bar's Office of Probation in Los Angeles within the same period.

Failure to do so may result in suspension. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(b).)

Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment. One third of the costs must be paid with her membership fees for each of the years 2018, 2019, and 2020. If GLORIA MARIA MAS fails to pay any installment as described above, or as may be modified by the State Bar Court, the remaining balance is due and payable immediately.

S243419**VALLEJOS ON DISCIPLINE**

Recommended discipline imposed: disbarred

The court orders that WILLIAM ARTHUR VALLEJOS, State Bar Number 140110, is disbarred from the practice of law in California and that his name is stricken from the roll of attorneys.

WILLIAM ARTHUR VALLEJOS must also comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 calendar days, respectively, after the effective date of this order.

Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.
